- 2. The presentation would be explained by the students as and when we report to college post the abolition of lockdown mandate and resuming of college.
- 3. The Presentation needs to be mailed to me positively by **5/04/20202**, **11.59 pm** at drvandana.srcc@gmail.com.
- 4. The late or non-sharing of the presentation online with me would lead to **non** consideration of the PPT for the internal evaluation.
- 5. In case of any ambiguity w.r.t the direction or content of the PPT, students can email me as and when required.
- 6. Any other relevant suggestions from students side would be appreciated and if deemed fit, can also be incorporated.
- 7. Please ensure the non-duplication of any country among two or more than two groups.

- 8. Further, there should a coordinator among each group, who will compile the PPT for his /her respective group and send to the class Representative. Class Representative, Abhishek/Mohit will compile all groups PPTs and after zipping the file, will share the same with me.
- 9. Group PPTs should include the name, roll numbers, name of the group coordinator and number of slides contributed by each group member.
- 10. Students can retain the same group members as previously decided for the class presentations.
- 1. Students can mutually decide and choose one country from the following countries:
  - a. Japan
  - b. United states of America
  - c. Republic of China
  - d. India
  - e. Russia
  - f. Sweden
  - g. Australia
  - h. Canada
  - i. U.A.E
  - j. Singapore
